

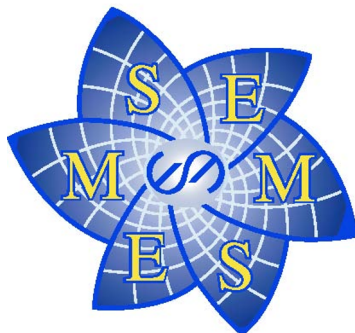
Diderot Mathematical Forum 2016

Each conference takes place simultaneously in three different European cities, exchanging information in streaming videos. The Diderot Mathematical Forum addresses each time a specific topic, and has both a research and a public component.
