It should be noted that the event will be held in-person.

The event may be recorded.

Notice is hereby given that participants in the event may be subject to audio-video filming. The data subject to processing, including images, of audio/video filming and recording (hereinafter, the "Images"), even in partial and/or edited or adapted form, made during the event will be processed, in full compliance with the GDPR.

The data will be processed, also with the aid of electronic means, by individuals specifically appointed for the dissemination and communication activities of the Politecnico di Milano. The Images collected will be stored, also in electronic form and on any technological support for the purposes and within the limits defined above and may be disseminated in accordance with Law no. 150/2000 on institutional websites as well as through social network channels (Facebook, X, Youtube by way of example but not limited to). Politecnico di Milano has the right to access or disclose the User's Images without any consent, by reason of art. 97 of Law no. 633/1941. Methods of data processing

Recipient categories

In relation to the stated purposes, the data may be transmitted to companies and/or persons, who provide services on behalf of the Holder for the realization, promotion and communication of the event as well as to other institutions hosting the event.

Transfer of data to non-EU countries or international organizations

Personal data will be processed by the Data Controller within the territory of the European Union. Rights of the interested party

As a data subject, you may at any time request from the Controller

- confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him/her exist;

- access to your personal data and information relating to them
- the rectification of inaccurate data or the integration of incomplete data;
- the deletion of personal data concerning you (upon the occurrence of one of the conditions set out in Article 17(1) of the Regulation and in accordance with the exceptions set out in paragraph 3 of the same Article)
- the restriction of the processing of your personal data (in the event of the occurrence of one of the hypotheses indicated in Article 18, paragraph 1 of the Regulation), the transformation into anonymous form or the blocking of data processed in breach of the law, including data whose storage is not necessary in relation to the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed.

As a data subject, you also have the right to object in whole or in part

- on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even though they are relevant to the purpose of collection
- to the processing of personal data concerning him/her for the purpose of sending communications aimed at promoting Politecnico di Milano training initiatives and events.
